

Theoretical Basis of Modern Forest Management and Forest Law

Modern forestry legislation is not conducive to the effective use of forest resources, forest management does not provide income. The most important element of forest relations regulation is information support of forest management and use of forests. For complete information about the state of forests can only be obtained in forest management. Modern materials of forest management are not high-quality forest planning information, forest management organizations and state control of forests. Over the past 10 years (2007–2016) adopted 34 amendments to the Forest Code of the Russian Federation and at the same time there is no substantial amendments to the issues of forest management. In order to improve forest relations in strengthening forest governance, improve the efficiency of forest management and forestry yields suggest amendments to the Forest Code of the Russian Federation – important changes approaches to management planning based on the classic forest management.
